- Interact with design staff to manage the Lighting Design and the BIM-Revit/CAD/Design (BRCD) process; explore strategies and methods for improving team workflow.
- Collaborate with design staff in developing a company BRCD standard execution plan and designer workflow reference guide.
- Oversee the application of BRCD software firm-wide; including installing, configuring, maintaining, and supporting all designer workstations.
- Help to analyze and solve BRCD user issues. Provide assistance with troubleshooting and problem resolution for BRCD software platforms. Be a Dedicated, consistent point of contact for designer questions and support.

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- Help design team develop strategies for effective delivery of quality documents and set up each project, thereby ensuring that each one is set up correctly.
- Oversee development process of family/block/symbol creation, management, and maintenance.
- Proactively implement incremental improvements of current BRCD software templates.
- Proactively perform incremental review of our libraries for optimization of use in rendering plug-ins (i.e., Enscape, Unreal Engine, etc.)
- Remain current with BRCD software training and best practice.
